



Shower Enclosure Cleaning Information

Keep Your Bathroom Ventilated: One of the best things you can do to keep your shower enclosure in its best condition is to keep the bathroom, as well as the door itself as well-ventilated, as possible. Proper ventilation of the enclosure helps prevent potential damage and growth of mold and mildew. Remember to keep a fan on, if possible in the bathroom, crack open a window: and always keep your shower door open for at least 15-20 minutes post-shower to allow for proper ventilation.

Squeegee Everyday: Taking a few minutes after each shower to squeegee your enclosure is a quick and simple way to keep the glass looking its best. Try applying light pressure from top to bottom, starting in the corners of the enclosure. If you would prefer not to use a squeegee, a cotton or microfiber towel may be used in its place. Remember to never use any abrasive materials on your glass enclosure.

Cleaning Spray: Wiping down your enclosure with a cleaning spray every week or two is a great way of maintaining your enclosure. It's also the best way to keep them looking spotless. Avoid any abrasive and strong chemical cleaners on the enclosure. Try to avoid anything with vinegar or baking soda. Avoid using these products on your shower enclosure hardware. You should only use water and a gentle soap on the hardware. Please take care to dry your hardware after cleaning, and in-between use to avoid rust and corrosion.

Try a Magic Eraser: A magic eraser helps to gently buff away soap scum and mildew. Magic Erasers can be found at many stores, and are very soft, non-abrasive items that can be used to clean off tough materials on your enclosure.
